What do my local tax dollars pay for?

The Huron County Board of Developmental Disabilities funds all providers of service for people with developmental disabilities. We fund the following adult day support services:

- Ability Works
- CLI, Incorporated
- First Choice of Ohio
- Flat Rock Community Services
- Goodwill Industries
- Rising Sun Centers

(Funding for providers is approximately 40% local dollars & 60% federal dollars.)

Services delivered by independent providers are funded by the Huron County Board of Developmental Disabilities as well.

Local dollars support the staff who monitor the quality of services delivered, develop the plan of support for each person, and ensure the health and welfare of the people we serve.

The county board also provides Early Intervention services for children from birth to age three and education for children ages 6 – 22 at Christie Lane School. The services of a Developmental Specialist, Speech Therapist, Occupational Therapist, Physical Therapist, and PLAY Project Coordinator are also available for each child based on need.

Additionally, Special Olympics activities are provided to adults, and Family Support Services are available to all non-waiver individuals served based on need.
